

OUR GOAL

Madhyamgram Municipality has taken a pledge to ensure basic civic needs to all citizens of this municipal area and to make all round development in both infrastructure and socioeconomic and to provide better health facilities to the weaker section through 04(four) UPHC and better treatment facilities at subsidized rate through super speciality Municipality Hospital. In order to ensure potable water supply to the Citizens we have completed Trans Municipal Water supple Project. To combat the natural disaster we have an NSG Hub at Badu Road. This municipality has been imparting an age oriented football coaching for sports development. This municipality is resolved to provide Shelter for Homeless people and uplift livelihood as well as socio- economic condition of poor citizen. We also give emphasis on good governance that this municipality could implement the development work properly and able to extend quality service to the citizens. Also we are determined to make the municipality open defecation free (ODF), Green City, and Solar city and slum free city.

OUR ACHIEVEMENTS

- Established a Tagore Culture Centre at Madhyamgram to promote cultural activities and to encourage the people to nurture their cultural trails.
- 2. NUHM & NULM Projects are being implemented successfully for ensuring all round development of weaker sections of the society especially poor women.
- Our ULB priorities the development work in slum areas and 25% of annual budget is allotted as PRO-poor fund for this purpose.
- 4. This ULB runs a 15 bed hospital with 11 bed ICCU, Maternity, Emergency, and Dialysis Unit, Upgraded pathology, X-Ray, ECG unit and OPD.
- 5. This ULB runs SARADA Ladies Hostel of 33 (thirty three) accommodation.
- 6. We have a 1000 capacity A.C. auditorium to promote cultural activities.
- 7. Badminton & Football coaching camps are running successfully under the proper guidance of eminent national level players to give an exposure to our budding talents.
- AMRUT, City Livelihood Centre, HFA, MISSION NIrmal Bangla,
 Mid-Day Meal, Kanyashree, National Social Assistance Programme (NSAP) / Schemes are being implemented successfully.
- 9. This ULB maintains 28 parks to provide a healthy environment to our citizens.
- 10. House to house garbage collection in each ward is being done on a regular basis since a long time.
- 11. We run a transparent administration in every sphere of municipal activities through introduction of e-governance, software, FA system etc.
- 12. This ULB already has introduced EPF scheme for all the casual.
- 13. This local body has an electric crematorium.
- 14. This ULB has already implemented RTI Act. and Right to public Service Act 2010, W.B.

- 15. BSUP Phase I, II & III Completed, Constructed building under BSUP I, II, III total 4094 no's in Madhyamgram Municipal area. Infrastructure works like Water supply, Street Light, road, drain, water harvesting, and solar lighting. Community Centre under this project. Total project cost compounded Rs. 14207.00 Lakh. This ULB has implemented BSUP Programs within stipulated time line.
- 16. To ensure 24 hrs. Purified water supply to every house hold a Trans Municipal Water Treatment Plant is being run successfully. And under AMRUT- 2 every household will be connected with potable water supply very soon.
- Integrated storm water drainage projects of cost Rs.7200 Lacs already completed to solve water logging at the time of rainy season.
- 18. Municipality has made seating arrangement and provide service quickly to senior citizen. Also made arrangement of Health Card to Senior Citizen.
- 19. A fire Station established at Madhya gram to combat fire disaster.
- 20. Municipal SAMADHAN APPs is started for registering grievance by the Citizens.
- 21. Already 35000 Nos Swasthya Sathi Family Cards have been issued to the citizens members under this Municipality.
- 22. "Somobathi" is being implemented successfully.
- 23. This Municipality has got 2nd prize for "Kanyashree" scheme implementation in 24 Parganas (North) in 2016
- 24. Shelter home for urban homeless people which is already constructed.
- 25. The enrolment of 'Swasthya Sathi' scheme among the eligible employee casual and permanent and the enrolment of members of Self Help Group. Civic Police, Health workers etc already done.
- 26. we have already introduced fully E-Service, OBPAS, E-mutation, E-Trade License etc.

ULB PROFILE

Madhaymgram Municipality, situated 25 Km away of Kolkata Municipal Corporation came into being in the year 1993. Total area is 21.56 Sq. Km and covered by 28 wards. The municipality is bounded by Barasat municipality to the North and North East, Dakshinhat Gram panchayat to the East, Banshpol and Gopalpur Chandigarh Gram Panchayats to the South and Masunda, Taldhari and Kapasia Gram panchayats to the West. Population of the town as per Census, 2011 is 1.96 lakh. Its population has increased from 0.86lac in 1991 to 1.55 lac in 2001 and nearly 1.96 lac in 2011 and projected to 2.39 lakhs by 2021, 2.82 lakhs by 2031. Gross population (Census) density is nearly 9090 p/sp km in 2011.
